Entry requirements

IFP: We require completion of the Senior Secondary School Graduation Certificate with an overall score of 80% in the final year (including 80% in our subject specific requirements for certain courses).

Undergraduate: Warwick IFP required for High School Graduates. High-calibre students from across China applying via CEIS (the China Excellence Identification Scheme) are very welcome to apply to Warwick. Students who are studying a Bachelors degree in China with excellent grades and a strong performance in the Gao Kao exam (Tier 1 score (一本)) may be eligible for direct entry in to Year 1 of an undergraduate degree at Warwick

Postgraduate: A score of 82% from a well ranked public institution is considered comparable to a UK 2:1 while a score of 77% is considered comparable to a UK 2:2. However, we take in to account the subjects studied as well as the institution studied at, and so requirements do vary

LEVELS OF STUDY AND HOW TO APPLY

Warwick International Foundation Programme (IFP) is a one year pre-university course designed for students whose academic qualifications do not permit direct entry onto a UK University undergraduate programme. warwick.ac.uk/ifp

Undergraduate study lasts for 3 or 4 years, graduating with a Bachelor's degree (majority with honours). Students apply via UCAS (ucas.com), enabling them to send one application to up to five courses. warwick.ac.uk/ug

Our **Postgraduate Taught Master's programmes** are typically one year in duration and include specialist modules as well as a significant amount of independent research. warwick.ac.uk/pg

Our **Postgraduate Research programmes** include Master's programmes by research, MPhil and PhD programmes. All applicants should submit a research proposal when applying and PhD applicants should have already agreed upon a supervisor before submitting an application to Warwick. warwick.ac.uk/pg

A GREAT LOCATION

ENGLISH LANGUAGE REQUIREMENTS

As all of our courses are taught in English, it is important to have a solid understanding of English before you can study in the UK. The level of English required will vary depending on the level of course and subject you are applying to, and are typically classified in 'Bands'. We accept a range of English qualifications.
